



~~Samuel J. Mast estate transfer, 117-449, was in error and all following transfers have made the same error. Mast had the following parcels when he died:~~

10.25 ac 76-148 (org. split from 25.54 ac pcl.)

10.0 ac 64-225 (had been 5 ac split from 25.54 ac pcl. and all of a 5 ac pcl once known as the Mose Wengerd 5 ac pcl in deed 46-215)

4.95 ac 79-450 (the original 25.54 ac with outsales of 5.34ac, 10.25 ac and the 5 ac split that was combined into the 10 ac pcl.)

5.66 ac 85-29 (once known as the 5.34 ac pcl.)

26.64 ac and 15.54 ac 79-450 (not part of the problem)

The executor's deed, 117-449, calls for:

25.54 ac, 26.64 ac, 15.54 ac, 5.66 ac

The 26.64, 15.54, and 5.66 ac pcls. are O.K.

The 25.54 ac pcl. covers only the 4.95, 10.25 and the 5 ac split that was combined into the 10 ac tract in deed 64-225. It does not except the 5.34 ac (now known as 5.66 ac) that was sold out in 54-160. The 25.54 ac parcel does not cover the 5 ac parcel once known as the Mose Wengerd 5 ac pcl. Therefore the 5 ac parcel ~~once known as the Mose Wengerd parcel has a last decided owner being Samuel J. Mast by virtue of deed 64-225.~~
