

Eve S. Miller and Frank Dye received a 10 ac and a 30 ac tract from their father in deed 88-261. In 88-262, Eva quitclaimed her int. to Frank for the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of the two parcels, being 20.575 ac. In 88-263, Frank quitclaimed to Eva his int. desc. as being the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of the two parcels, being 20.575 ac.

When Eva sells in 112-170 it is desc. as 1 ac out of a 10 ac tract and the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of the 10 & 30 ac parcels. The total being $19\frac{1}{2}$ ac.

The grantee in 112-170, Bert Forbes, sells out 13.5 ac to James D. & Cora M. Dye in 112-294. The 13.5 ac begins 18' north of the quarter section line.

When Forbes sells to Herbert R. & Donna Johnson in 122-57, the deed says 1 ac, $S\frac{1}{2}$ of 10 & 30 ac, total conveyed being 19.5ac ex. 13.5, leaving after ex. 6 ac.

Doesn't mention the 18' south of the 13.5 ac parcel which is on a deed to Harold Troyer, 167-404, as .75 ac.

The 6 ac was resurveyed and sold to Harold Troyer in 207-740 as 6.68 ac.
