Journal Entry stated that Olive L. Hofer had the use and control of the property until the youngest child reached the age of 16 years. Then John was to have control over the property.

I could not find a deed from John Hofer to Sidney Hofer. However, in the Auditor's duplicate a transfer shows from John Hofer to Sidney Hofer dated 7/29/54. The only deed I could find was 130/12 From Emil W. & Virginia H. Hofer to Sidney Hofer bearing the date 7/29/54 but was only a Quit Claim Deed. It is possible that Emil W. and Virginia H. Hofer were the heirs of John F. Hofer.

The correction deed on 204/220 stated that Robert D. Hofer was to only receive $\frac{1}{2}$ int. and that Beulah Hofer Spahr was to have $\frac{1}{4}$ int. and Ellen Hofer Murray was to have $\frac{1}{4}$ int. This was to correct deed 173/100.
