Ques. Do you suppose that the blaze on the trees were the same made by Mr Robinson, when he surveyed your land?

Ans. I suppose they were, there seemed to be two sets of blazes on the same trees and crossed above the spring about where it did when first run.

Ques. When Mr Robinson, commenced to run back did he run straight back north?

Ans. I cannot tell whether or not, does not recollect of seeing any fence here at the time of the above survey.

Also came Peter Jolly, of lawful age, being first duly sworn according to law & oath; that he came along some time after Mr Robinson had run the line for Mr Wm Bird, and saw a bearing tree, and thinks that he saw a stake standing just within the field east of the fence, which ran north and south near where the peach trees now stand; does not recollect the kind of a tree, saw a notch was taken out and notch cut rather on the north east side of the tree as near as he can recollect.

Ques. by Mr Spurgew. Where was you going when you saw it? Ans. I cannot say where I was going, I happened along and saw it; saw no blazes running from it; from appearance I took it to be a corner; does not recollect what was in the field, saw but one bearing tree, saw no survey or - the stake stood rather north east, maybe about north from the bearing tree, does not recollect the time of year.
