

ORDINANCE NO. 141

ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF HOLMESVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Holmesville, Holmes County State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the annexation of the following described territory:

Being a part of the Northeast part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 3 of Township 13, Range 13, and beginning at the northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter; thence south 4 degrees west on the east line of said Section 3, 487.5 feet to an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of Lot No. 80 of the Homestead Addition to the Village of Holmesville; Thence North 85 degrees and 30 minutes west on the North line of said Homestead Addition, 974.0 feet to an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot No. 96 and on the East Right-Of-Way line of the Pennsylvania Railroad; thence in a Northeasterly direction on the east line of said Railway Co., 613 feet to a point on the North line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section 3 and in the center of County Road No. 192; thence South 86 degrees east on said North line and on the center of County Road, 592.0 feet to the place of beginning.

Be the same hereby authorized.

SECTION 2: That the Solicitor, W. C. Pyers, be and hereby is authorized to prosecute the proceeding necessary to effect such annexation.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
