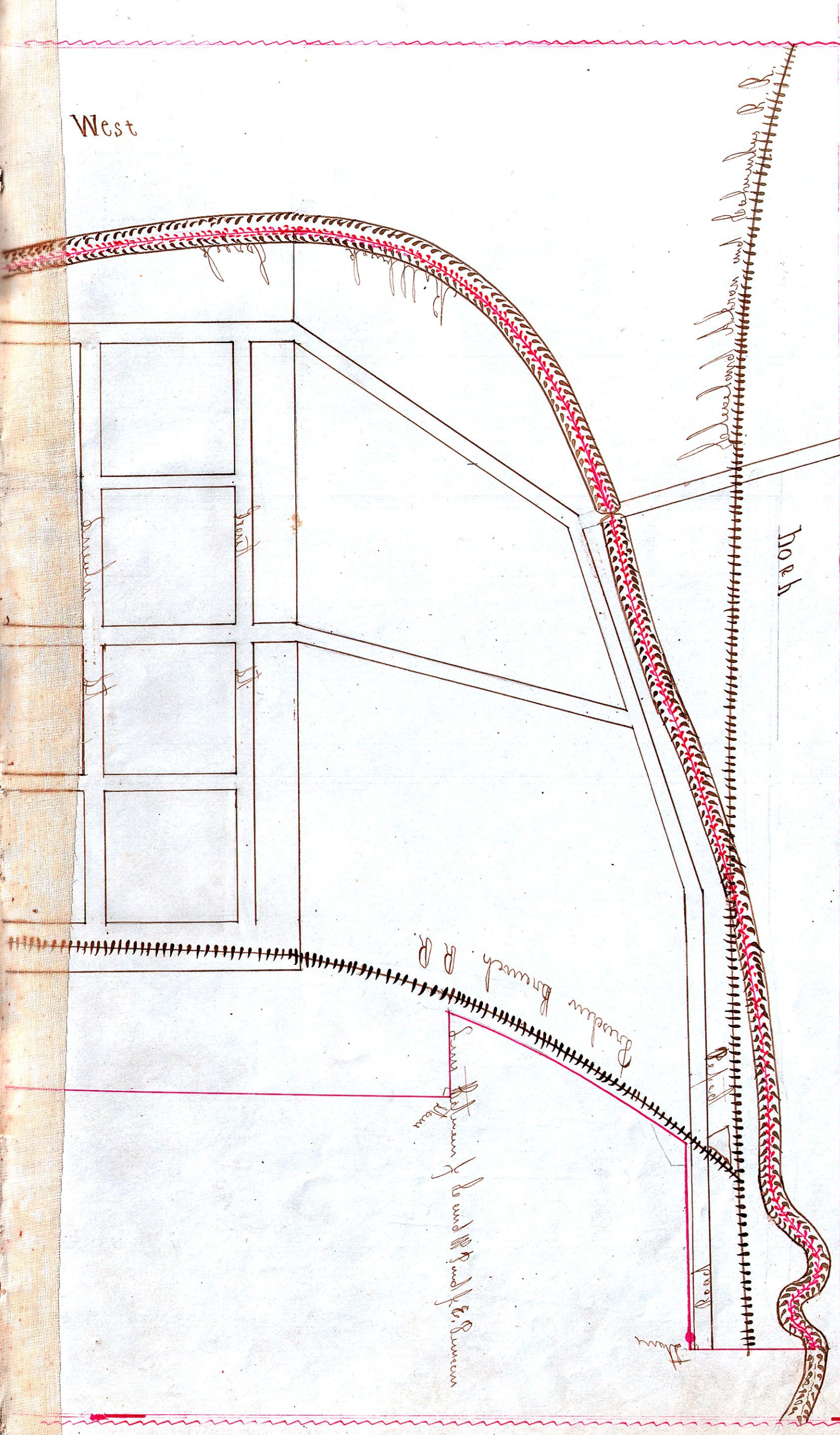


West

 in the Matter of the Annexation of the Territory to the
 Incorporated Village of Killbuck Ohio

 Millersburg Ohio, March 1895. In the matter of the Annexation of Territory to the
 Incorporated Village of Killbuck Ohio.

On the 4th day of March 1895. Said Board being in regular session
 A Petition was presented to said Board praying for the annexation of certain territory
 in said petition described: to to the incorporated Village of Killbuck Ohio, which was
 duly filed on said day in the office of the Auditor of said county.

This Board fixed the 7th day of May 1895, at 10 A.M. at the courthouse
 in said County for the hearing of said Petition and ordered notice to be given of
 the time and place of said hearing in the Holmes county Journal used by Posters
 in the County sought to be annexed as provided by law.

In the matter of annexation of certain Territory to the Incorporated Village of
 Killbuck Holmes County Ohio,

Before the Board of Commissioners of Holmes county Ohio
 This Matter this 7th day of May 1895, came on for hearing pursuant to the order
 made by this Board March 4 1895, with the full Board present and it being
 established to the satisfaction of the Board by public hearing this day by
 evidence that the Incorporated Village of Killbuck Ohio, through its council
 duly passed an ordinance by a majority vote thereof authorizing the annexation
 to said Village the territory in the Petition described, that said Village by said
 ordinance authorized its Solicitor to prosecute the proceedings necessary to
 effect such annexation that the Petition herein was presented to this Board
 at its regular March Session 1895, and was duly filed in the office of the
 Auditor of said County, that said Petition states further that under said
 ordinance passed by said Village as aforesaid, the territory in said Petition described
 was authorized to be

annexed to said Village; that the Petition contains an accurate
 description of said territory that said Petition is accompanied by an accurate
 Plat of said territory that said Petition is signed by the persons authorized
 by law and the said ordinance to prosecute the proceedings for the annexation of
 said territory to said Village; that notice containing the substance of the
 Petition and the time and place of this hearing was published in the Holmes
 County Journal or Newspaper printed and of general circulation in said
 Holmes County, for a period of six consecutive weeks prior to the hearing
 and commencing in the issue of paper on the 7th day of March 1895,
 that copies of said Notice were posted on each of the several tracts proposed
 to be annexed to said Village

On the 14th day of March 1895, the same being not less than six weeks prior to the hearing; and that all necessary preliminary steps in this matter have been properly taken, and said board of commissioners viewing same to pass on the merits of this matter from the testimony, find that the Petitioner contains all the matters required by the statutes in such cases that the statements of the Petitioner are true that the tract of each of said tracts proposed to be annexed to said village are accurately described and are not in either tract unnecessarily large or small; that the map or plat accompanying said Petition and bounding the several tracts proposed to be annexed is accurate, that the Person who name is subscribed to said Petition was duly authorized in the premises by said village; that notice has been given as required; that it is right and proper that the prayer of said Petition be granted; It is therefore on this 17th day of May 1895. ordered by the Board that the territory described in said Petition be and the same is hereby annexed to said Incorporated Village of Killbuck and made part thereof as prayed for in the Petition; that the recorder enter all the proceedings and orders made by the board in this matter upon the journal and cause a transcript thereof together with the petition and plat to be forwarded to the Clerk of said Incorporated Village

 authorized by virtue of an ordinance passed by the council of the incorporated Village of Killbuck Ohio. by a majority vote thereof at a meeting held on the 7th day of February 1895. the following territory hereafter described was authorized by the action of said council in the passage of said ordinance (a copy of which is herewith attached) to be annexed to the said incorporated Village to wit: Beginning at the south west corner of the occupation line at the south side of alley and center of Killbuck creek; thence south in the center of said creek to a stone on bank of said creek; thence in easterly direction sixty (60) feet north of Joseph Kaufman's picket fence to a stone on hill; thence in northerly direction to the south west corner of graveyard fence; thence northerly along said fence to J. D. and W. Duvessins fire fence; thence west on line of said fence to the East line of the Right of way of the Dresden branch Railway; thence in a northerly direction on said easterly line of Right of way to the Public Road fence; thence in North East direction along said fence to a stone; thence North to center of Killbuck creek;

Thence South in center of Killbuck Creek to the place of Beginning;
A plot of said Territory above described is herewith attached and made part
of this Petition and filed herewith and shews the lines and boundaries
of said Territory to be annexed as aforesaid to said Village,

Said ordinance further authorizes and delegates P. P. Bass, to proceed as soon
- practicable and to proceed according to law and cause said Territory to be annexed
to said Village. Therefore I P. P. Bass, pray your honorable body to take such
action as is provided by law to cause said Territory to be annexed to said Village
And we the undersigned land owners residing on said Territory to be annexed
do ask of your honorable body to grant this our Petition and Prayer and that
the said Territory as described in this Petition be annexed to the Incorporated
Village of Killbuck Ohio.

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Ordinance No 45

An ordinance passed by the council of the Incorporated Village of Killbuck Adams County Ohio this 11th day of January 1895, for the enlarging of the Corporation of the above said Village.

Sec 1st be it remembered by the council of the Incorporated Village of Killbuck Adams County Ohio, that the Corporation of said Village shall be enlarged by annexing the following described territory to wit: Beginning at the South West corner of the Corporation limit at the South side of alley and center of Killbuck Creek. Thence South in center of said Creek to a stone on bank of said Creek thence in Easterly direction sixty (60) feet North of Joseph Carpenters Picket fence to a corner stone on hill, thence in a Northerly direction to the South West corner of brownwood fence thence Northerly along said fence to J. C. and W. Cummings line fence. Thence west on line of said fence to the East line of Right of way of the Dresden branch Railway. Thence in Northerly direction on said Easterly line of Right of way to the Public Road fence. Thence in a Northerly direction along said fence to a stone. Thence North to center of Killbuck Creek. Thence South in center of creek to place of beginning.

Sec 2nd be it further ordained that P. P. Base be and is hereby appointed to prosecute the proceedings necessary to complete such annexation according to law
Sec 3rd be it further ordained that this ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and due notice given by posting as required by law, done at the council chamber this 11th day of January A.D. 1895,

Sec 2nd Ordinance accepting the annexation papers of Adams County Commissioners for the annexation of Territory to the Village of Killbuck Adams County Ohio,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Killbuck Adams County Ohio as follows:

Sec 1st that the application of the council of the Incorporated Village of Killbuck in said county and others for the annexation of the following described Territory to the Village of Killbuck: a certified transcript of the Proceedings of the County Commissioners together with the Petition Map and other papers relating thereto are on file with the Village Clerk. A. S. Beginning at the South West corner of the Corporation line at the South side of alley and center of Killbuck Creek. Thence South in center of said Creek to a stone on bank of said Creek; Thence in a Easterly direction sixty (60) feet North of Joseph Carpenters Picket fence to a corner stone on hill; Thence in a Northerly direction to the South West corner of brownwood fence.

Thence Northward along said fence to S. B. and M. P. Purness line fence;
 Thence west on line of said fence to the East line of Right of way of the
 Brecken Branch Railway; Thence in a Northward direction on said Easterly line
 of Right of way to the Public Road fence; Thence in a North East direction
 along said fence to a stone; Thence North to center of Killbuck Creek;
