

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AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION ON APPLICATION OF OWNERS OF REAL ESTATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mohican Area Growth Foundation, Inc., and Robert D. Thompson and Eleanor Thompson petition the Commissioners of Holmes County, Ohio, for the annexation of certain real estate situated in Washington Township, Holmes County, Ohio, to the Village of Loudonville, Ashland and Holmes Counties, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, all proceedings by the Holmes County Commissioners have been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Holmes County Commissioners adopted a resolution granting the petition for annexation filed by the Mohican Area Growth Foundation, Inc. and Robert D. Thompson and Eleanor Thompson, and releasing that property to be annexed to the Village of Loudonville on the 7th day of August, 1989; and

The Village Clerk shall then forthwith deliver one (1) copy to the Holmes County Auditor, one (1) copy to the Holmes County Recorder, and one (1) copy to the Secretary of State of the State of Ohio, and shall do all other things required by law.

Section 3:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection of the property of the residents of the Village of Loudonville, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to complete the annexation proceedings initiated by the petitioners Mohican Area Growth Foundation, Inc., and Robert D. Thompson and Eleanor Thompson so that said real estate may be further developed in accordance with the site plan submitted to the Ashland County Planning Commission for said property as soon as possible by the engineering and construction of a manufacturing facility, and for the further reason that tax revenues concerning said real estate may be received by the Village as soon as possible, and for the further reason that the Village may proceed with infrastructure improvements to said real estate once it is incorporated into the Village, and shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.

Resolution for Annexation

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of June, 1989, there was filed with the Holmes County Commissioners a Petition signed by the President and Secretary of the Mohican Area Growth Association and Robert D. and Eleanor Thompson, husband and wife, seeking annexation of property adjacent to the Village of Loudonville, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, said Petition was set for hearing on Monday, August 7, 1989, at 2:00 p.m., and a notice of the substance of said Petition and the time and place where the hearing would be held was published once a week for a period of four (4) consecutive weeks in the HOLMES COUNTY HUB beginning on the 15th day of June, 1989; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the notice of said hearing was sent to the Clerk of the Village of Loudonville and the Washington Township Clerk by certified mail, return receipts received; and

WHEREAS, the hearing was held at the time and place advertised, a transcript of which is attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Loudonville has adopted Village Ordinance 43-89, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the Holmes County Commissioners have found according to law that:

- 1. the Petition contains a full legal description and accurate map or plat of the territory sought to be annexed.
- 2. the Petition contains a statement of the number of owners of the real estate and the territory sought to be annexed.
- 3. the Petition contains the name of the person or persons to act as agent for the Petitioners.
- 4. notice was published according to law.
- 5. the persons whose names are subscribed to the Petition are owners of real estate located in the territory in the Petition, and as of the time the Petition was filed with the Board of County Commissioners, the number of valid signatures on the Petition constituted a majority of the land owners of real estate in the territory proposed to be annexed.
- 6. the territory included in the Petition was not unreasonably large.
- 7. the general good of the territory sought to be annexed would be served if the Petition was granted.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Holmes County Commissioners hereby grant the annexation petition at issue and release said property to be annexed to the Village of Loudonville. The Clerk of the Holmes County Commissioners shall deliver the Petition, the map, and all other papers on file, to the Clerk of the Village of Loudonville.

LOUDONVILLE ANNEXATION HEARING - (MOHICAN AREA GROWTH ASSOCIATION)

The hour of 2:00 p.m. having arrived as the time set aside and advertised for a hearing to determine whether or not to annex to the Village of Loudonville 34.864 acres located in Washington Township and more fully described in this Journal, page 270 (Resolution of County Commissioners). Chairman Lee declared the hearing open and recognized the presence of Janice Kick, Clerk of Washington Township Trustees, Jeff Allerding, Washington Township Trustee and Lou Fritz and Dwight Mathias of the Mohican Area Growth Foundation.

Jeff Allerding began comments by stating that Washington Township is asking that the Village include T.R. 457 in the annexation. Mr. Allerding has ascertained that the road is not capable of withstanding the anticipated increase in traffic once Merrillat Industries is operational. The surface of TR 457 would need to be raised in some places, the road widened, and drainage problems exist. The cost of improving and maintaining this road would be a hardship for Washington Township, according to Mr. Allerding. Mr. Fritz stated that the description of the land to be annexed does not include any part of TR 457, that the time involved to go back and include the road would be "crippling" and could possibly mean the end of the project (building of the Merrillat Industries factory). Mr. Fritz also stated that he could not speak for the Village Council regarding the annexation of TR 457, or of the Council's intentions. The issue is valid, but when and how it is handled is critical to the project. Mr. Mathias agreed with Mr. Fritz and also explained that it was not anticipated that the traffic on TR 457 would increase substantially because there will be no access to the road, the access to the plant will be from SR 39 and SR 3. In fact, it is expected that a fence will separate the factory from TR 457, thereby preventing access totally. It is also anticipated that there will be a substantial number of employees bussed to work, thereby eliminating a large amount of traffic. Mr. Allerding maintained that people will be taking "shortcuts" to and from work to avoid traffic conjection and would use TR 457 for that reason. A telephone conversation between the Mayor of Loudonville and Mr. Fritz and Mr. Allerding was made in an attempt to alleviate concerns regarding TR 457. Mr. Allerding stated that he did not want to hold up the Merrillat project and for that reason would not stand in the way of the amnexation, however, he felt that "good faith" discussions for the future would be necessary to resolve this problem.
