I do hereby certify that the above is a correct plat of in lots situated on Subdivision Out lot number 41. East of the original town plat of Millersburg the County seat of Holmes County Ohio. The above in lots are 53 1/2 feet in front, (fronting on Liberty Street) and 127 feet back. Alleys 16 1/2 feet wide, except the alley on the North of said lots, which is 10 feet wide. A stone 18 inches long and 4 inches diameter at the top, planted at the south west corner of in lot number one to mark future surveys from, said stone being also planted at the south west corner of Subdivision Out lot No. 41. on which the above in lots are situated.
