# <u>BID OPENING - COUNTY ROAD 200 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT – COMMISIONERS</u> <u>MEETING</u>

The hour of 10:15 a.m. having arrived, three bids were received for the County Road 200 Bridge Replacement. The first bid from Bud's, Inc was in the amount of \$223,906.75, the second bid from Berlin Contractors in the amount of \$210,589.45 and the third bid from Rietschlin Construction in the amount \$222,575.00. Engineer Chris Yong will review the bids and award at a later date.

# **BID OPENING - COUNTY ROAD 201 ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT**

The hour of 10:15 a.m. having arrived, three bids were received for the County Road 201 Road Resurfacing Project. The first bid from Melway Paving Option 1 black top only was in the amount of \$673,577.00 and Option 2 with rubber tires in the amount of \$861,862.80, the second bid from Kokosing Option 1 black top only in the amount of \$777,158.76 and Option 2 with rubber tires in the amount of \$899,983.76 and the third bid from Superior Paving Option 1 black top only in the amount \$\$753,348.14 and Option 2 with rubber tires in the amount of \$970,994.04. Engineer Chris Yong will review the bids and award at a later date.

# KEN SMAILES & STEVE KNOWLING- EXECUTIVE SESSION DISCUSSION

Ken Smailes of WKLM and Prosecutor Steve Knowling met with the Commissioners and discussed the reasons for going into Executive Session. The reason for the meeting is that Smailes wrote a letter to the Commissioners questioning some of the reasons for going into Executive Session. The Commissioners responded back with a letter asking for specific meetings.

Miller started off the meeting by telling Smailes that the Commissioners take their job seriously and that we appreciate him and Paula Wilcoxon covering the Commissioners Meetings. Miller stated that the Commissioners have done a lot less Executive Sessions then before. Miller is interested in what Smailes thinks that the Commissioners have violated.

It involves the Executive Sessions pertaining to contract negotiations and personnel. Smailes states that contract negotiations has not been clarified and just personnel is used frequently without the explanation with it. For example – discipline, evaluation, interview etc.

Knowling informed the Commissioners that contract negotiations is not a reason to go into Executive Sessions, it would have to be something along the line of purchase of property, lease of property if it pertains to the County Landfill, you cannot use contract negotiations.

Smailes would like to see the Commissioners be more specific when naming the reason for going into Executive Session.

Miller would like to see the Clerk take the lead in this and make sure the Executive Sessions are done properly now and in the future.

Ault stated the County wants to do thing right and appreciates Smailes coming in.

Smailes acknowledged that it was never his intent to state that the Commissioners have done something wrong.
