Walnut Creek township Holmes County Ohio and all other
Supervisors through whose district the following road is
located

You are hereby authorized to proceed to open the
following County road established by the Commissioners
of said County at their June Session 1857.

" Commencing at the cross road on the farm of Jonas
Stutzman in Walnut Creek township in said County near
the Walnut Creek bridge being on the North West quarter
of Section twenty one, township nine and range five,
thence a North Eastern Course, thence through a cor-
ner of the South East quarter of Section twenty, along
an old road that is now open, and thence a
North Eastern Course along said old road through the
South East quarter of Section twenty, and thence a
North Eastern Course along said old road through
the South West quarter of section 16 to intersect a
County road near the barn of Elias J Miller on
said quarter section sixteen and there to terminate
and to keep the same in repair thirty feet wide.
