

The foregoing is a correct Plat of Mechanics Town as laid out on the 12th and 15th days of November A.D. 1840. Situate in Coshocton County Ohio, near Doubly's fork of Killbuck as follows to wit, all that part of said Town lying North of the center of Croft Street as marked on said Plat; is laid out on Lot number thirty four in the third quarter of the eighth Township and sixth Range of United States Military Lands, and all that part of said Town lying South of the center of Croft Street as marked on said Plat is laid out on the North West quarter or fraction of section five in Township seven and Range six of the lands directed to be sold at Zanesville.

Said Town contains twenty six lots as marked on said Plat of following dimensions - Lots numbered one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten & eleven, being all the lots on the South side of Croft Street are five rods square. Lots numbered fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty one, twenty two, and twenty three, each front on Main Street, four rods and all except nineteen and twenty extend five rods back as marked on said Plat, nineteen and twenty being fractional lots as marked on the Plat. Lots numbered twelve, thirteen, fourteen, twenty three and twenty each front on Croft Street five rods and extend back by the course of the lines as marked on said Plat four rods.

Lot number twenty five as marked on said Plat by the name of Church Lot, is fifteen rods and nine links by ten rods. Lot number twenty six with the Spring on it is five rods by six rods - The Streets are four rods wide and the Alleys one rod wide except Church Alley which is fifteen links wide -

Croft Street runs due east and west, since that part of main Street which lays South of Croft Street runs due north and south, and that part of Main Street which lays north of Croft Street runs from said Croft Street north twenty two degrees west.

The Proprietor hereby donates the Streets and alleys in said Town for public highways -

Lot number twenty five, marked "Church Lot", the proprietor hereby donates to the citizens of said Town for the express purpose of meeting a Church or Churches thereon from time to time as they shall think proper.
