Plan of the Town of Mifflinburg in Coshocton County Ohio as laid out on the first day of November A.D. 1815 Main Street Bridge Street High Street and Market Street are fifteen rods wide and the rest of the streets three rods wide the alleys are all sixteen feet wide the lots numbered 100, 61, 75, 77, 14, 58 are reserved for future purposes the North tier of lots under the lots fronting on Bridge Street are forty feet front and one hundred and twenty feet back the residue of the lots are sixty feet front and one hundred and twenty feet back except what the alleys take off of them the streets and alleys run due north and south and East and West. The proprietors reserve all the ground between the town lots and streets for their own use either to improve by way or to lay out in lots their option as it may be the creek for bridges miles & 6th The Beginning corner of said town is the Northwest corner of lot number thirty four from which corner all lots in the town must be governed in their boundaries and situation This town is situated on the tenth side of section number twelve in Township number nine and Range number seven the District of County Officers for sale at Zanesville Ohio State of Ohio Coshocton County ss At Johnston Brothers Miller & Proctor - Recorders Office & Entered in my Office per Recorder and Recorded December 1st Anno Domini 1815. This instrument made this twenty ninth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen between Isaac Edgington and Sarah his wife of the County of Adams and State of Ohio of the one part and Andrew Ellison of the County of Adams and State of Ohio afterwaids of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of ninety five dollars paid him in hand paid the receipt whereof the deach marriage the had above granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Andrew Ellison his heirs and assigns a certain tract of Land containing one hundred acres lying and being in the County of Coshocton and State of Ohio aforesaid being Lot twenty of section four of Township ten of Range six the same being patented in the name of Isaac Edgington bearing date the twenty third day of January 1815. I have and do hold the said premises and every part and parcel thereof together with all and singular the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Andrew Ellison his heirs and assigns forever to his and their only use and benefit and the said Isaac Edgington and Sarah his wife for themselves their heirs &c doth covenant promise and agree to and with the said Andrew Ellison his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and forever defend the said tract of Land and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Andrew Ellison his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them their heirs and all and every person or persons whatsoever.
