



# Plat of Winesburg

Winesburg is situated on the East part of Lot No 33. Township 10. Range 4. and 3<sup>d</sup> section in the County of Holmes and State of Ohio. (Size of the Lots) Lots No. 2, 3, 24 and 25. is 44 1/2 feet in front and 155 feet back, the remaining Lots is 49 1/2 feet in front and 155 feet back - (Streets) Main Street is 66 feet wide, with an addition of 10 feet on each side for a publick walk, Walnut, Chestnut and Wood Streets are 35 feet wide, with an addition of 5 feet on each side for a publick walk. (Alleys) the alleys are 33 feet wide. Bearings, N. 60 1/2° E. and N. 21 1/2° W. the South East corner of Lot 9. is the standard corner. Surveyed, March 14<sup>th</sup> 1832 by Samuel Robinson, Surveyor -
