## Description 5.001 acre parcel

Commencing at a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found marking the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section 5, thence N 01 degrees 49' 57" E 596.32 feet along the quarter section line to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found, thence $N 32$ degrees $39^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ E 222.74 feet along David A. and Dorothy Yoder's (O.R. vol. 175 page 2844) west line to an iron pin set the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

2) N 43 degrees $18^{\prime} 58^{\prime \prime}$ W 175.63 feet through the lands of said Yoder to an iron pin set;
3) N 30 degrees $03^{\prime} 50^{\prime \prime}$ E 95.65 feet through the lands of said Yoder to an iron pin set;
4) N 05 degrees $59^{\prime} 38^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 307.10$ feet through the lands of said Yoder to an iron pin set;
5) N 89 degrees $08^{\prime} 22^{\prime \prime}$ E 214.93 feet (passing into the southeast quarter of Section 5) through the lands of said Yoder to an iron pin set;
6) N 24 degrees $31^{\prime} 24^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 179.27$ feet (passing into the southwest quarter of Section 5 ) through the lands of said Yoder to an iron pin set;
7.) N 17 degrees $19^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 91.87$ feet through the lands of said Yoder to an iron pin set;
7) N 12 degrees 31' $18^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 402.12$ feet through the lands of said Yoder to a point in the center of T.R. 164, witnessed by an iron pin set S 12 degrees 31 ' 18" E 59.43 feet;
8) N 39 degrees $11^{\prime} 57^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 0.68$ feet along the centerline of T.R. 164 to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found;
9) N 35 degrees $11^{\prime} 18^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 67.35$ feet along the centerline of T.R. 164 to a point, witnessed by an iron pin set $S 17$ degrees $42^{\prime} 42^{\prime \prime}$ E 78.42 feet;
10) $S 17$ degrees $42^{\prime} 42^{\prime \prime} E 1068.61$ feet (passing into the southeast quarter of Section 5) along said David A. and Dorothy Yoder's west line to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found;
11) S 32 degrees 39' 36 " W 272.00 feet along said David A. and Dorothy Yoder's west line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

This parcel contains 5.001 acres, but subject to all highways and easements of record. Containing 2.928 acres in the southeast quarter and 2.073 acres in the southwest quarter of Section 5.
