

Description 0.0115 acre parcel – (D)

Being a part of the Village of Millersburg, Lot 42, First Quarter, Hardy Township, T-9 N, R-7 W, Holmes County, Ohio, also known as a part of a 20 foot alley aka Diamond Alley, to be vacated.

Described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch rebar found marking the northeast corner of Lot 12 of Pleasant View Glass Plant Addition, Block 7 (Plat vol. 1 page 357-362) the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

thence with the following FOUR (4) COURSES:

- 1) N 89 degrees 56' 40" E 10.00 feet to an iron pin set on the centerline of said Diamond Alley;
- 2) S 00 degrees 48' 36" W 50.00 feet along the centerline of said Diamond Alley to an iron pin set on the north line of Cary Street;
- 3) S 89 degrees 56' 40" W 10.00 feet along the north line of Cary Street to a point marking the southeast corner of said Lot 12, witnessed by an axle found S 55 degrees 00' 12" W 0.50 feet;
- 4) N 00 degrees 48' 36" E 50.00 feet along the east line of said Lot 12 and along Jack L. Davis and Susan F. Davis' (O.R. 268 page 2106 – PN 0700622000) east line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

This parcel contains 0.0115 acres, but subject to all highways and easements of record. To go to adjoiner.


All iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebars with a plastic identification cap marked "Baker Surveying LLC".
