## Description 48.947 acre parcel

Being a part of the southeast and southwest quarters of Section 2 and northwest quarter of Section 9, Killbuck Township, T-8 N, R-8 W, Holmes County, Ohio, also known as part of the lands conveyed to Gladys P. Weaver in Official Record vol. 196 page 102, PN 0800285003.

16) S 08 degrees $36^{\prime} 34^{\prime \prime}$ W 1853.03 feet through the lands of said Weaver to an iron pin set;
17) S 01 degrees $48^{\prime} 02^{\prime \prime}$ W 893.93 feet through the lands of said Weaver to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found on the section line;
18) $N 86$ degrees $47^{\prime} 31^{\prime \prime}$ W 756.99 feet along the section line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

This parcel contains 48.947 acres, but subject to all highways and easements of record. Containing 26.795 acres in the southeast quarter of Section 2, 9.515 acres in the southwest quarter of Section 2 and 12.637 acres in the northwest quarter of Section 9.

All iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebars with a plastic identification cap marked "Baker 6938". Bearings from Plat vol. 19 page 984.
