Brg.-S 59 degrees $49^{\prime} 41^{\prime \prime}$ W, Ch.-55.22 feet along the centerline of T.R. 91 an arc distance of 55.41 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

2) $S 50$ degrees $19^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 589.47$ feet along said Shepler's west line to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found on That Dam Trust and Thomas C. Douglas, Trustee's (D.V. 275 page 991) north line, witnessed by an iron pin set N 50 degrees $19^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime}$ E 172.74 feet;
3) N 45 degrees $23^{\prime} 58^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 176.09$ feet along said Douglas' north line to a point in a creek, witnessed by an iron pin set N 50 degrees 19' 13" E 192.89 feet;
4) N 50 degrees $19^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 480.56$ feet through the lands of said Coblentz to a point in the center of T.R. 91, witnessed by an iron pin set S 50 degrees 19' 13" W 13.96 feet;

Brg.-S 80 degrees $36^{\prime} 07^{\prime \prime}$ E, Ch.-203.42 feet along the centerline of T.R. 91 an arc distance of 213.99 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
