Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Holmes, and Township of Knox, known as being a part of Northwest Quarter and Northeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 19N, Range 15W of the Congress Lands North of the Old Seven Ranges, and being part of Holmes County Parcel No. 10-00031-000, a 4.641 acre tract of land in the name of DOUGLAS E. CLINE AND TINA M. CLINE as described in O.R. 257, Page 4143, all records are on file in the Holmes County Recorder's Office, and being a tract of land lying on the left side of CR 23 (Wally Road) centerline of right of way, as shown on plans designated HOL-MOHICAN VALLEY TRAIL PHASE I on file with the Holmes County Engineer, and being more particularly described as follows:

Thence North $85^{\circ} 04^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East along the northerly line of said Section 19 and said Germann tract, a distance of 290.80 feet to a point being 30.00 feet right of centerline Station $14+13.43$, on the southerly right of way line of said CR 23, a tract in the name of Holmes County Board of Commissioners as recorded in O.R. 277, Page 5981, said point being referenced by a $5 / 8$ " iron pin with cap marked, "Rudolph - 6449," found 29.90 feet right of centerline Station 14+13.68;

Thence North $85^{\circ} 04^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East along the northerly line of said Section 19 and through said right of way, a distance of 170.24 feet to point being 30.00 feet left of centerline Station 15+72.75, and on a northerly line of said right of way and a southwesterly corner of a tract of land in the
name of Richard Germann as recorded in O.R. 220, Page 173, said point referenced by a 5/8" iron pin with cap marked, "Rudolph - 6449," found 30.14 feet left of centerline Station 15+73.00;

Thence 1351.61 feet with a curve along said northerly right of way line, the southerly line of said Germann tract and the southerly line of a tract of land in the name of Peggy J. Claes, Trustee as described in O.R. 274, Page 1756, curving to the left with a radius of 5700.00 feet, a delta angle of $13^{\circ} 35^{\prime} 10^{\prime \prime}$ and whose chord bears South $81^{\circ} 53^{\prime} 15^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 1348.44 feet to a point being 30.00 feet left of centerline Station $29+31.48$, referenced by an iron pin with cap marked, "Baker Surveying LLC," found 30.07 feet left of centerline Station 29+31.41;

Thence 170.07 feet along said northerly right of way line, being the southerly line of said Claes tract and the southerly line of said Grantor's 4.641 acre tract, curving to the left with a radius of 2835.00 feet, a delta angle of $3^{\circ} 26^{\prime} 14^{\prime \prime}$ and whose chord bears North $89^{\circ} 36^{\prime} 03^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 170.05 feet to a point at the intersection of said northerly right of way line and the easterly right of way line of CR 230 ( $40^{\prime}$ R/W), being 30.00 feet left of centerline Station 31+03.35 and being the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein being described;

Thence North $57^{\circ} 05^{\prime} 34^{\prime \prime}$ West, with said easterly right of way line, a distance of 54.63 feet to an iron pin set 61.00 feet left of centerline Station 30+57.64;

Thence through said Grantor's tract, the following seven (7) courses:

1. South $75^{\circ} 16^{\prime} 34^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 86.62 feet to an iron pin set 36.00 feet left of centerline Station 31+42.00;
2. North $86^{\circ} 12^{\prime} 56^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 131.34 feet to an iron pin set 35.00 feet left of centerline Station 32+75.00;
3. South $05^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 02^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 3.00 feet to an iron pin set 32.00 feet left of centerline Station 32+75.00;
4. With a curve to the left having an arc length of 449.76 feet, a radius of 2833.00 feet, a delta angle of $9^{\circ} 05^{\prime} 46^{\prime \prime}$ and whose chord bears North $79^{\circ} 54^{\prime} 05^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 449.29 feet to an iron pin set 32.00 feet left of centerline Station $37+29.84$;
5. North $75^{\circ} 21^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 40.66 feet to an iron pin set in the Quarter Section line of said Section 19, being 32.00 feet left of centerline Station 37+70.49;
6. North $75^{\circ} 21^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 79.51 feet to an iron pin set 32.00 feet left of centerline Station 38+50.00;
7. North $67^{\circ} 58^{\prime} 49^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 133.06 feet to an iron pin set in the southwesterly line of a tract of land in the name of Aaron D. Stacy and Krista L. Andre, as described in O.R. 246, Page 3264, said point being 53.33 feet left of centerline Station 39+78.03;

Thence South $63^{\circ} 26^{\prime} 49^{\prime \prime}$ East, with said southwesterly line, a distance of 16.92 feet to the southwesterly corner of said Stacy and Andre tract, being 43.24 feet left of centerline Station $39+91.17$ and referenced by a $7 / 8$ " iron pin found 43.30 feet left of centerline Station $39+91.15$;

Thence South $62^{\circ} 15^{\prime} 39^{\prime \prime}$ West, with the southeasterly line of said Grantor's tract, a distance of 44.99 feet to a point in the northerly right of way of C.R. 23, being 30.00 feet left of centerline Station $39+49.24$ and referenced by a $5 / 8$ " iron pin found 30.19 feet left of centerline Station 39+49.29;

Thence with said northerly right of way line and the southerly line of said Grantor's 4.641 acre tract, the following 3 courses:

1. 81.31 feet curving to the left with a radius of 1462.00 feet, a delta angle of $3^{\circ} 11^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$, and whose chord bears South $76^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 48^{\prime \prime}$ West, a distance of 81.30 feet to a point 30.00 feet left of centerline Station $38+69.59$ and referenced by a $5 / 8$ " iron pin and cap "Baker Surveying LLC" found 30.13 feet left of centerline Station 38+69.56;
2. South $75^{\circ} 21^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ West, a distance of 139.75 feet to a point 30.00 feet left of centerline Station 37+29.84 and referenced by a $5 / 8$ " iron pin stamped "Baker Surveying LLC" found 30.16 feet left of centerline Station $37+29.81$;
3. 619.93 feet curving to the right with a radius of 2835.00 feet, a delta angle of $12^{\circ} 31^{\prime} 44$ ", and whose chord bears South $81^{\circ} 37^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime}$ West, a distance of 618.70 feet to the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described area contains 0.098 acres, more or less, of which the present road occupies 0.000 acres, more or less, which is part of Holmes County Auditor Permanent Parcel Number 10-00031-000.
