3) S 81 degrees $02^{\prime} 43^{\prime \prime}$ E 173.93 feet along Lindsey Sutton, Elaine Sutton and Tina Sutton's (O.R. 230 page 1022) south line to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found;
4) S 01 degrees $03^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 119.26$ feet along the west line of Lot 1 of Hillside Subdivision (Plat vol. 18 page 516) and along Levi D. Nisley and Clara M. Nisley's (O.R. 266 page 4090) west line to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found;
5) N 88 degrees $51^{\prime} 52^{\prime \prime}$ E 19.14 feet along the south line of Lot 1 of said Hillside Subdivision and along said Nisley's south line to a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found;
6) S 12 degrees $10^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 174.03$ feet along the west line of Lot 1 of said Hillside Subdivision and along said Nisley's west line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
