3) N 74 degrees $40^{\prime} 06^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 304.75$ feet along the centerline of C.R. 320 to a point;
4) Along a curve to the left having a delta angle of 09 degrees $56^{\prime} 48^{\prime \prime}, R-860.00$ feet, T74.84 feet, Ch. Brg.-N 79 degrees 38 ' 31 " W, Ch. 149.11 feet along the centerline of C.R. 320 an arc distance of 149.30 feet to a point at the intersection of C.R. 320 and T.R. 522;
5) N 50 degrees $50^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime}$ E 92.25 feet (passing into Fractional Section 24) along the centerline of T.R. 522 to a point, witnessed by a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found $N 50$ degrees $50^{\prime} 04^{\prime \prime}$ E 45.64 feet;
6) Along a curve to the left having a delta angle of 66 degrees $16^{\prime} 51^{\prime \prime}, \mathrm{R}-70.00$ feet, T45.70 feet, Ch. Brg.- N 17 degrees $48^{\prime} 54^{\prime \prime}$ E, Ch. 76.54 feet along the centerline of T.R. 522 an arc distance of 80.98 feet to a point, witnessed by a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found N 15 degrees 12' $16^{\prime \prime}$ W 70.44 feet;
7) Along a curve to the right having a delta angle of 28 degrees $33^{\prime} 07^{\prime \prime}, \mathrm{R}-276.94$ feet, T-70.47 feet, Ch. Brg.-N 01 degrees $01^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ W, Ch.-136.58 feet along the centerline of T.R. 522 an arc distance of 138.01 feet to a point;
8) N 13 degrees $10^{\prime} 14^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 38.56$ feet along the centerline of T.R. 522 to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

This parcel contains 3.007 acres, but subject to all highways and easements of record, Containing 1.918 acres in Fractional Section 24 and 1.089 acres in Lot 21.
