10) S 01 degrees $35^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ E 355.00 feet along the centerline of S.R. 60 to a point;
11) Along a curve to the left having a delta angle of 17 degrees $30^{\prime} 00^{\prime \prime}, R-572.96$ feet, T88.19 feet, Ch. Brg.-S 10 degrees $20^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{Ch} .-174.32$ feet along the centerline of S.R. 60 an arc distance of 175.00 feet to a point;
12) $S 19$ degrees $05^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime} E 209.63$ feet along the centerline of S.R. 60 to a point;
13) Along a curve to the right having a delta angle of 07 degrees $24^{\prime} 00$ ", $R-1909.86$ feet, T-123.51 feet, Ch. Brg.-S 15 degrees $23^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ E, Ch.-246.50 feet along the centerline of S.R. 60 an arc distance of 246.67 feet to a point;
14) S 11 degrees $41^{\prime} 12^{\prime \prime}$ E 260.84 feet along the centerline of S.R. 60 to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
