1) N 01 degrees $54^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} 166.00$ feet along the east line of Harrington Street to an iron pin set, witnessed by a $5 / 8$ inch rebar found $S 88$ degrees $50^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime} E 0.97$ feet;
2) $S 88$ degrees $50^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ E 146.88 feet along Joseph G. Kline and Dolores A. Bretz's (D.V. 275 page 588) south line to an iron pin set;
3) S 07 degrees $48^{\prime} 56^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 168.80$ feet partly through the lands of said Village of Glenmont and partly through the lands of said Catholic Church Diocese of Columbus to an iron pin set on the north line of Main Street;
4) $N 88$ degrees $05^{\prime} 27^{\prime \prime}$ W 129.50 feet along the north line of Main Street to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
