## Description 5.100 acre parcel

7) S 64 degrees $30^{\prime} 59^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 87.29$ feet along the centerline of T.R. 605 to a R.R. spike set;
8) S 67 degrees $43^{\prime} 17^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 94.86$ feet along the centerline of T.R. 605 to a R.R. spike set;
9) S 73 degrees $41^{\prime} 44^{\prime \prime}$ W 92.26 feet along the centerline of T.R. 605 to a R.R. spike set;
10) S 81 degrees $23^{\prime} 50^{\prime \prime}$ W 183.70 feet along the centerline of T.R. 605 to a R.R. spike set;
11) S 84 degrees $15^{\prime} 57^{\prime \prime}$ W 134.56 feet along the centerline of T.R. 605 to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
