

James Woods called by James Moorhead & John Cifna
to prove that the Original corner stood some 30 l^{ys}.
East of where it is at present (south of corner of L5 T13 R13)

James Woods sworn

Ques. 1st How long has it been, since you first saw a corner
where that stone stands.

Ans. About 2 Years.

James Woods testified that he had seen a stone or stake
standing for some 2 years where Moorhead & Cifna contended
for the corner, but never saw any trees standing near that
resembled witrip Trees.

He (Woods) testified that he had been present when David
Buchanan made search for witrip trees, with field notes
found some roots, that he supposed to be the remains of
witrip tree - being asked to point out the course they
were found - the course he showed did not agree
with field notes.

From all the information I could get I was satisfied
that the stone that Moorhead & Cifna contended for, was
not in the proper place. The oldest settlers could not
say that they ever saw any witrip trees standing near
I therefore set the corner agreeably to law, equidistant
between section corners.
