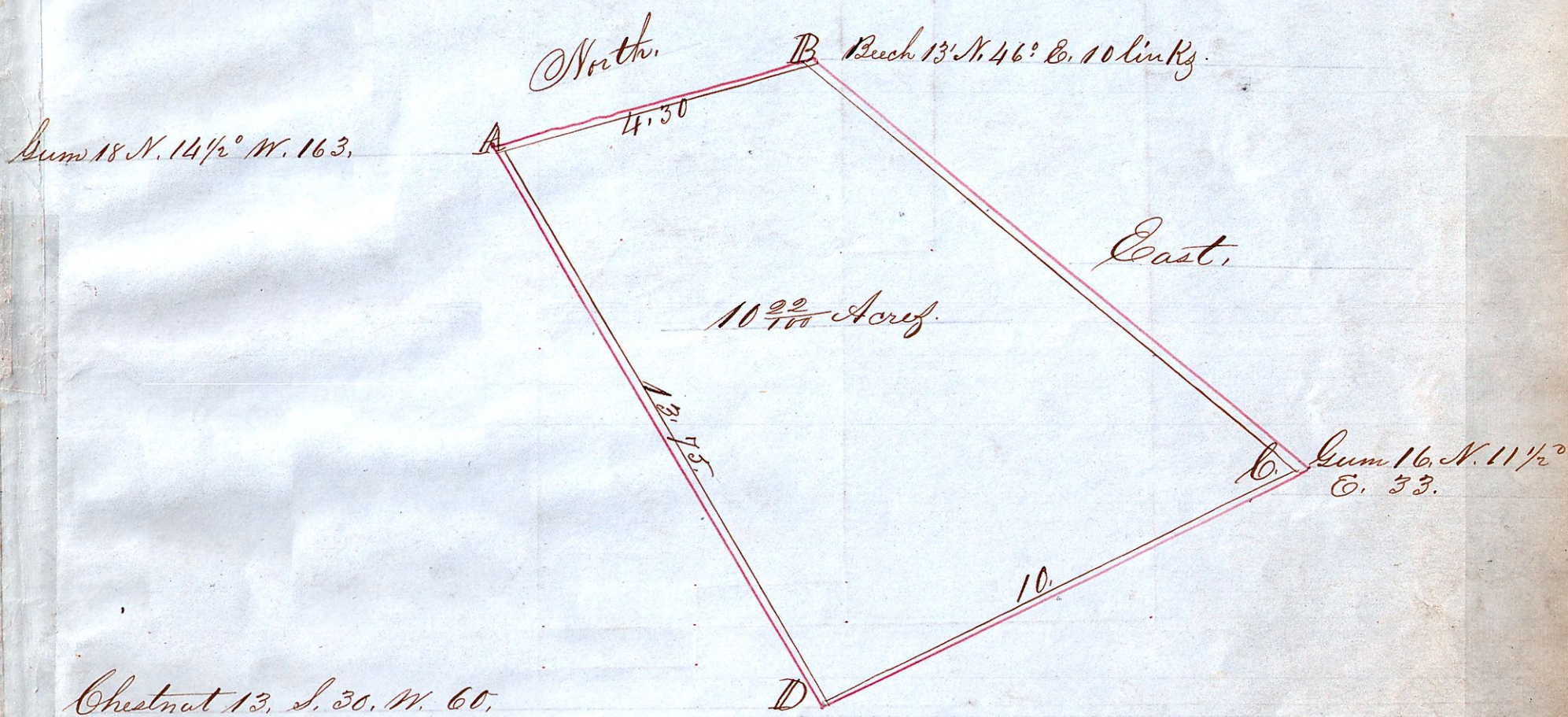

Plat of Joseph Koehler's Lands.



The above plat, represents $10 \frac{2}{10}$ acres, surveyed for Joseph Koehler in the W. W. Part of Lot No. 29, 3^d Section 4th. Range. 10. E. of bounds as follows, Commencing at the W. W. corner marked (A) from which a Gum 18 inches in diameter bears North $14 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. distant 163 links. Thence $S 15 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 13 chains 75 links to a stake (D) Thence $N 74 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 10 chains to a stake (C). Thence $N 36 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 15 chains 80 links to a stake (D). Thence $S 62^{\circ}$ W. 4 chains 30 links to the place of beginning. Surveyed June 29th A. D. 1850.
