The Public Square on the above plat is sixteen perches by twelve perches Jackson street and Clay street are each four perches wide the other streets are all three perches wide public alley court house alley and service alley & Christian alley are all six or seven feet wide the residue of the alleys are all ten feet wide the lots are each four perches by eight perches except what the alleys take off, situated as marked on the above plat the public square together with the streets and alleys are donated for public use the north west corner of the public square is hereby established as the standard corner of said town from which courses and lots streets and alleys must be regulated
