

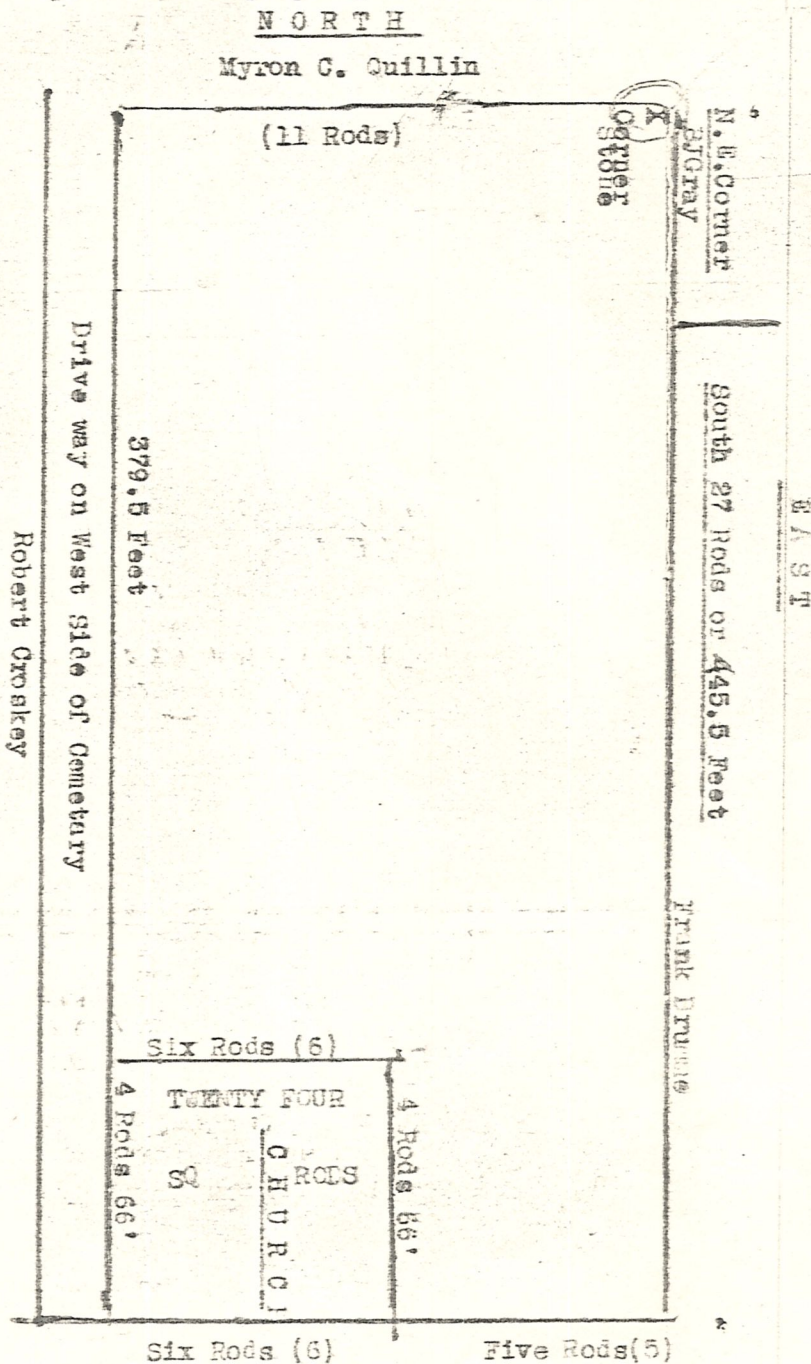

THAT Edward E. Shepler and Leota M. Shepler his wife & Bertha Jacob and H.G. Jacob her husband to :----- THE MILLERSBURG SEVENTH DAY ADVERTIST CHURCH, Grantee, its heirs and assigns forever the following Real Estate situated in the County of Holmes in the State of Ohio, and Township of Killbuck and bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section Fourteen, Township Eight, Range Seven: Thence South along the East Section-Line, Twenty-Seven Rods: Thence West: Five Rods to the Starting-point of the lands herein conveyed: Thence West Six (6) Rods: thence North Four (4) Rods: Thence East, Six Rods(6) thence South, Four Rods to starting-point of the lands herein conveyed; and containing Twenty-four (24) Squared Rods of Land more or less.

In view of the fact that all surveys must have a bonifide starting point, this survey was started at the North-East corner at a Corner-Stone on the lands of M.C. Quillin on the North and Brantley J Gray & Frank Brumme on the East continuing South(27 Rods) 445.5 Feet to the County Highway thence West Five (5) Rods to South-East corner of church thence continuing West Six Rods (6) to South-West corner of church thence North Four Rods(4) to North-West corner of church Thence East Six Rods (6) to North-East corner of church thence Four Rods (4) to place of beginning of church survey.
