

Description 20 foot convenience easement

Being a part of the northeast quarter of Section 31, Paint Township, T-15 N, R-11 W, Holmes County, Ohio, also known as part of the lands conveyed to Mark Allen Weaver and Elsie E. Weaver in Official Record vol. 211 page 3277, PN 1500938003 and part of the lands conveyed to Robert A. Hershberger and Linda Sue Hershberger in Deed vol. 273 page 484, Official Record vol. 211 page 3272 and Official Record vol. 211 page 3274, PN 1500938001 and PN 1500938002.

Commencing at a 5/8 inch rebar found at the intersection of T.R. 656 and C.R. 200 marking the northeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 31, thence S 00 degrees 09' 57" E 1592.28 feet along the section line and along T.R. 656 to a point the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

thence N 87 degrees 09' 17" W 985.65 feet along the centerline of said 20 foot convenience easement and through the lands of Mark Allen Weaver and Elsie E. Weaver (O.R. 211 page 3277) and Robert A. Hershberger and Linda Sue Hershberger (D.V. 273 page 484, O.R. 211 page 3272 and O.R. 211 page 3274) to a point and THERE ENDS.
