- A. Stone found quarter corner on S. line of Sec. 15" Maple N.E. 9.2' blazed, 6" W. Oak W. of N. 10.0 blazed, 8" W. Cherry S.W. 18.2 blazed
- B. Stone found - half quarter corner 10" W. Oak N. of W. 12.0', 15" W. Oak W. of N. 11.2', 15" Black Oak E. 20.5, 6" Black N.E. 14.0'
- C. Iron pin set on N. side of traveled road, 10" Gum N. 82° 20' E. 31.0', 4" W. Cherry S. 4° E. 17.7', 18" Red Oak N. 28° W. 16.0'
- D. Iron pin set 12" W. Oak W. of N. 14.8', 10" Beech N. of W. 57.6
- E. Iron pin set on N. side of road opposite rail fence - west trunk of twin W. Oak S. 16.9', 15" W. Oak N.E. 26.4
- F. Iron pipe set on south side of traveled road about 100' E. of Farm lane
- G. Large fence post on N. side of lane
- H. Iron pin set in N. side of road on line
- I. Iron pipe set at the N.E. corner of road intersection - piled stones around
- J. Stone & tile set in fence corner, 4" Dogwood 1' west blazed
- K. Stone and tile set in fence corner
- L. Stone and tile set in fence corner, 15" twin White Oak E. 16.6' rail trapped between twins, 15" W. Oak S. 18.8', 15" Twin White Oak W. 36.0'
- M. Stone and tile set in fence row considered as property line, 20" forked W. Oak 40.5' S.W., 20" Hick. W. 10.8', 15" W. Oak S of W 34.5
- N. Stone and tile set at fence corner 8" W. oak W. 7.6 blazed, 6" Bl. Oak S. 13.1 blazed, 8" white oak fence tree N. 8.8'
- O. Stone brick set at fence corner, Twin Walnut N. of W. 12.4, 8" Elm N. 29.7, 24" Elm E. 25.7' - Creek is E. & S. 30'
