

SURVEYORS REPORT.

To the Board of Commissioners of Holmes County, Ohio: The undersigned, in obedience to your order dated August 5<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1902, proceeded on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August, 1902, to survey and map the station in Adams County road described in said order, under the direction of the undersigned named, and respectfully submit the following return of said survey: Commencing for the center of the road 20 feet north of a stone bearing 17 feet and 10 inches north of the center of the bridge of Richard Shaw, said starting point is on the east line of the southeast quarter of section 26 in Township No. 20 of Range No. 15, in the center of the County Road leading west from Hubertville, in Washington Township, Union 5" S 70' W 30' L. There north 67' west 26 feet to a post, 6' L. north 16' L. There north 98' west 8 feet 3 inches to a post; There north 69' 2" west, 6' fence to a post; Walnut 12" north 52' 6.3' ft. There north 20' west 8 feet to a post; Walnut 12" east 30' fence; whole distance 98' fence.
